I would be grateful if you would review a paper entitled "Critical success factor identification and strategy formulation for implementation of green construction projects in Indonesia: stakeholders' perspectives" for this journal.

This is the abstract:

The purpose of this paper is to formulate strategies to improve green construction project implementation by identifying factors that need to be improved due to low performance. Out of 20 selected possible success factors, a total of 17 were approved as success factors in Indonesia context. A quantitative approach was adopted, and thus, based on literature findings, 30 questionnaires were compiled from respondents from in green construction projects. The methodologies to analyse the findings were inter-rater reliability analysis and importance–performance analysis, which includes gap analysis and quadrant analysis. Strategies to implement green construction were identified by a qualitative approach through interviews conducted to elicit expert professionals' experiences.

The findings from gap analysis suggests differences in both importance and performance ratings that lead to negative signs, it appears that, given the importance of an item, its performance is still potentially problematic and need remedial decisions. Then, this study revealed that green construction implementation strategies could be focused on two main drivers, namely construction management and technologies application. The paper contributes to the knowledge of the perceptions of industry practitioners by focusing exclusively on the success factors gap in managing green projects in the context of Indonesia.


