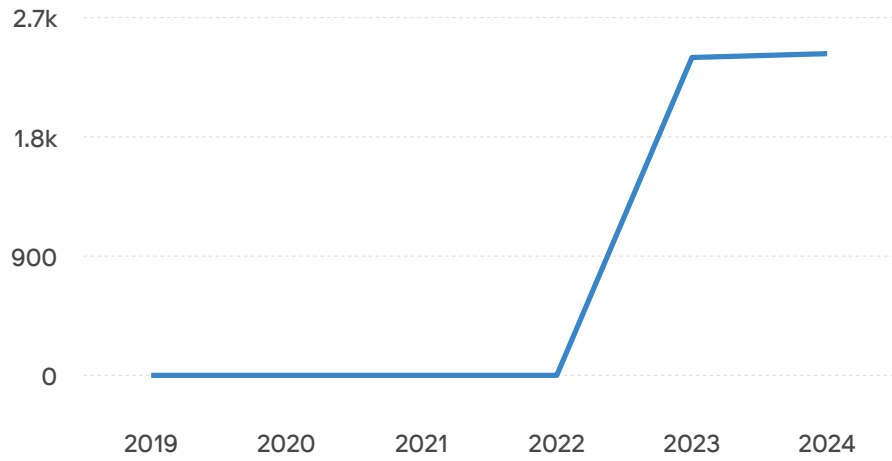




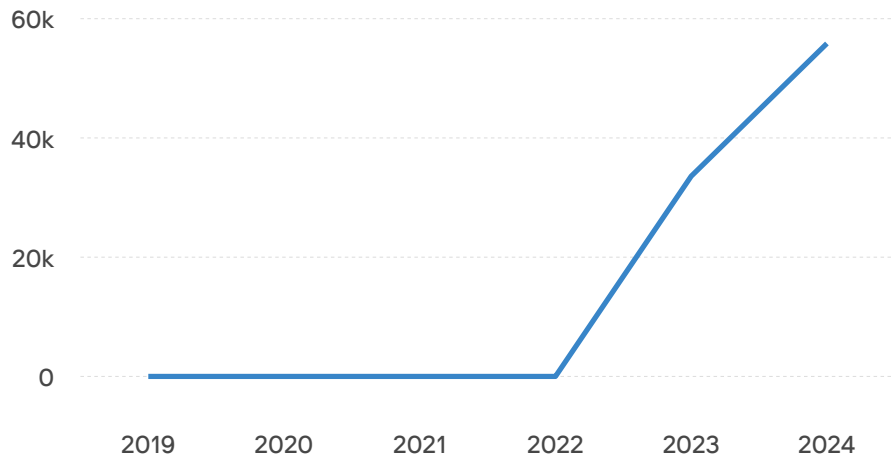


% Female Authors





Estimated financial value

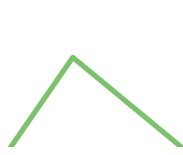

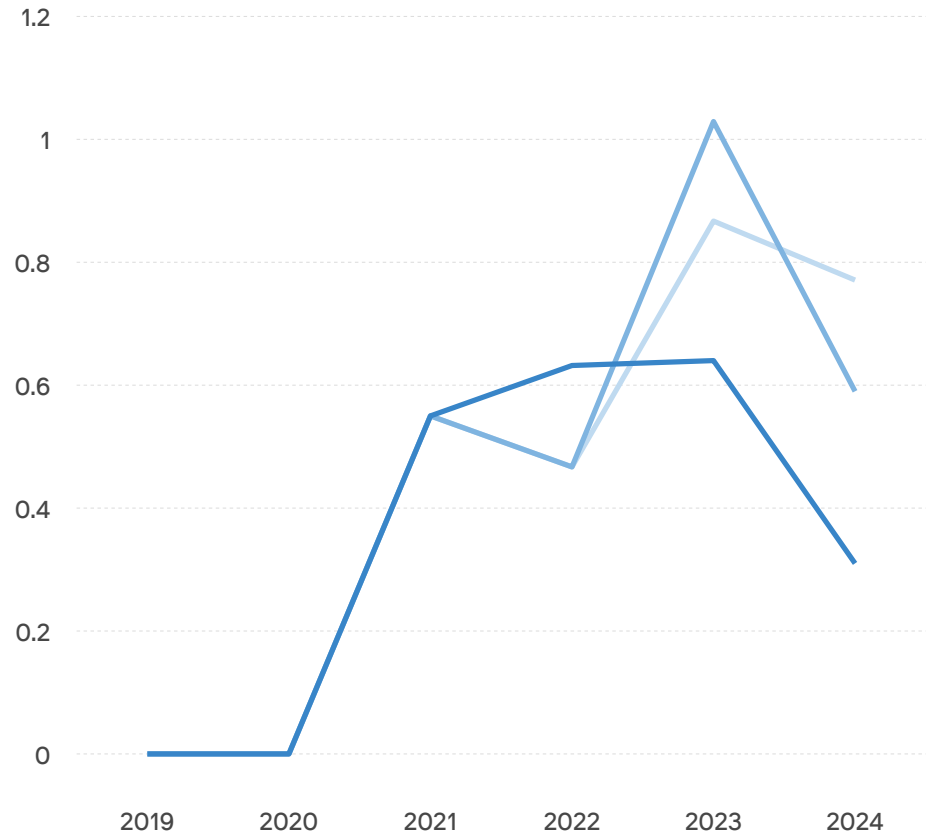

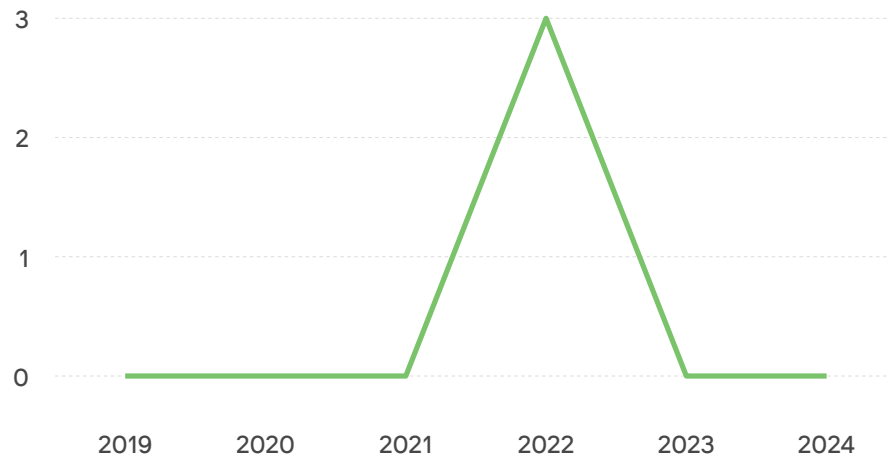
