Introducion

- The relationship between an individual and his group is an interaction between an individual and other people.
- Through the process of socialization, individuals learn to know and understand what to do and what not to do
- Ethnic socialization involves social interaction between individuals and their environment.
- Individual development is influenced by proximal processes that involve interactions and also the people who convey the information (Bronfenbrenner, 2005).

Introducion

- The socialization process depends on the individual receiving it and also who or what the individual receives at a particular time.
- In this study, young people of Chinese ethnicity were selected, because ethnic socialization was limited to Chinese ethnic socialization.

Research question:

How is the pattern of ethnic socialization that occurs among young Chinese people in Jakarta?

Theoretical Framework

According to Ihromi (2004) socialization is a learning process experienced someone to gain knowledge of skills, values and norm so that he can participate as a member in his community group

Socialization is a process that must be passed by young people to obtain values and knowledge about their groups and learn about their social role that matches their position there (Goode, 2007).

Hughes et al. (2006) mentions ethnic socialization there are four dimensions, namely cultural socialization, preparation of bias, promotion of mistrust, and pluralism.

Method

- Research design is descriptive method
- Sample taken is a nonprobability sampling, in particular, convenience technique sampling
- Error margin for sample is 10%, min 68 respondent
- Filling the questionnaire takes about 10-15 minutes.
- Questionnaire made in the Google Form to facilitate charging.
- Questionnaire distributed in mid -February to the end of February 2025.

Result

- Respondents in this study were 70 students consisting of the 50 women (71.4%) and 20 men (28.6%).
- They most (53 people or 75.2%) are Indonesian Chinese because of their parents, 14(20.0%) only his father is Indonesian Chinese, and three people (4.3%) of his mother the ethnic Indonesian Chinese.
- The most family members affecting the mother, 60 respondents (85.7%) said so. Father only selected by 6 people (8.6%).
- On campus, the person who most influences is college friends. As much 65 respondents (92.9%) said college friends were the most people influence on campus.

Conclusion

- The most influential person for respondent is the mother if it is related to the family.
- When respondents were on campus, college friends were people the most influence it. The influence of these people will certainly give influence in ethnic socialization.
- The average value of ethnic socialization is in the category of tends to be high, as well as the cultural socialization and pluralism dimensions. In the dimensions of preparation of bias and the promotion of mistrust dimensions are in the category tend to be low. It can be said that respondents feel fine when interacting between ethnicities, namely interacting between ethnic Chinese and other ethnic groups outside the ethnic Chinese.
