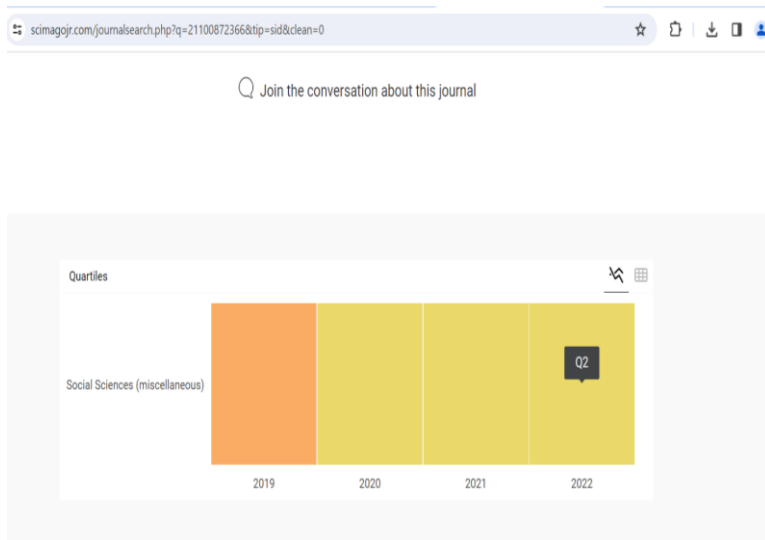

Abstract:	Entrepreneurial attitudes drive economic development. However, despite its importance, young people lack entrepreneurial skills, increasing unemployment. Therefore, thanks to the limitations of the scientific literature, the objective is to explore research trends on entrepreneurial intention in women. A systematic review of the literature based on PRISMA 2020 is proposed, synthesizing the quantitative and qualitative literature on the subject. Research on entrepreneurial intention among university women has grown exponentially, focusing on "self-efficacy". Concepts such as "Covid-19" and "entrepreneurial passion" are highlighted. Pre-vailing theories include TPB, which provides a solid framework. Attitude, subjective norms, self-efficacy, entrepreneurial education, and behavioural control are key variables. Gaps include preference for TPB and lack of understanding of emerging economies and gender. A comprehensive agenda is needed to address these gaps and advance the understanding of entrepreneurial intentions among university women.
