Pihak Pertama dan **Pihak Kedua** sepakat mengadakan Perjanjian Pelaksanaan Pengabdian kepada Masyarakat Skema Penugasan Tahun 2024 Nomor **0305-Int-KLPPM/UNTAR/IV/2024** sebagai berikut:

Pasal 1

- (1). **Pihak Pertama** menugaskan **Pihak Kedua** untuk melaksanakan Pengabdian "Pengenalan Budaya Indonesia sebagai Implementasi Kerjasama dan Pelestarian Budaya: Pembelajaran Tari Tradisional Bagi Mahasiswa di Vietnam"
- (2). Besaran biaya yang diberikan kepada **Pihak Kedua** sebesar **Rp 30.000.000,-** (tiga puluh juta rupiah). diberikan dalam 1 (satu) tahap sebesar 100%. Pencairan biaya pelaksanaan penelitian diberikan setelah penandatanganan Perjanjian ini.

Pasal 2

- (1) **Pihak Kedua** mengumpulkan **laporan akhir, laporan keuangan dan luaran**.

THE JAIPONG MOVEMENT HAS A PHILOSOPHY OF NGIRIK (KNOCKING OUT THE RICE GRAINS FROM THE STALK), NUTU (POUNDING THE RICE), AND NAPI (SEPARATING THE GRAINS IN THE RICE).

Bukaan Movement as the movement that begins the dance. Dancers enter the dance area by walking on their toes and circling the stage.

Pencungan Movement is a variety of fast movements in dance accompanied by music with a fast tempo

Ngala Movement is a movements that have a stopping point before the player performs another movement that is done quickly.

Mincit Movement is the transition from one movement to another performed after the ngala movement.

Goyang Karawang

Jaipong Dance is a traditional dance from West Java province or Sundanese. According to Indonesian cultural history of this dance was created by Gugum Gumbira. He led Jugala Group and has created dances so well-known and spread throughout Indonesia during the 1980's. "Goyang Karawang" is a form of Jaipong as a Traditional Karawang dance.



TOR-TOR *HORBO PAUNG*

The Tor-Tor Horbo Paung dance has a profound significance, signifying that an individual with honour is one who adheres to moral principles and abides by them. This implies a limitation on one's personal autonomy in navigating life. In executing the Tor-Tor movement, there are several fundamental movements that must be mastered, namely:




MULA - MULA

The movement of opening both hands towards the chest, this movement symbolizes a beginning that starts from a clean and sincere heart.



MANOMBA

It is a movement by combining both palms and then moving up and down. This movement means to worship.



MANGURDOT

Movement by moving the foot up and down to the heel, this movement means that there is a sign of life or a beginning to start what will be done.



MANERSER

The movement of the feet to the left and right, this movement means to open the way to get blessings.
